GFAN Africa is a social movement that mobilizes advocates to achieve the ambitions for sustainable health financing in Africa. GFAN Africa leads civil society and community efforts on Global Fund advocacy and Domestic Resource Mobilization advocacy.

Global Fund

In 2002, in an act of extraordinary global solidarity and leadership, the world came together to create the Global Fund to fight what were then the deadliest pandemics confronting humanity: HIV/AIDS, Tuberculosis (TB), and Malaria. Over the 20 years that followed, this unique partnership has invested more than US\$53 billion, that has saved **50 million** lives and reduced the combined death rate from the three diseases by more than half in the Countries in which the Global Fund invests

The investment case launched by Global Fund for the Seventh Replenishment called for raising at least US\$18 billion. This is the minimum required to get the world back on track toward ending HIV, TB and malaria, to build resilient and sustainable systems for health and strengthen pandemic preparedness, making the world more equitable and safer from future threats. The US\$18 billion would save 20 million lives, cut the death rate from HIV, TB and malaria by 64% between 2024-2026.

In the 7th Global Fund Replenishment, Contributions totaled to USD 15.7 Billion which misses the target set to get back on track to ending HIV TB and Malaria. The African region, communities and civil society are looking to ensure that their governments make the necessary investments. For Post replenishment activities, GFAN Africa will convene Africa civil society and communities in a review and planning meeting in Nairobi, Kenya.
