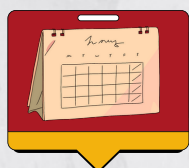

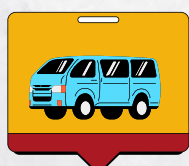

Travel

Take note of the departure and arrival date and time on your ticket to avoid missing your flight. WACI Health will not be liable for any additional costs related to missing the flight.



Airport Shuttle Arrangements

WACI Health will organize for airport pick-up and drop-off to and from the Hotel. At the arrival exit, you will find someone carrying a signpost with WACI Health on it.



Meals

Health break teas and lunch will be provided during the workshop.



Per Diems

WACI Health will reimburse Per Diems in accordance with WACI Health policy to cover dinner and other incidentals. Please remember to present your boarding pass to facilitate this process.



Currency Exchange Rate

The monetary unit is the Kenyan Shillings (KSHS) at the latest exchange rate, **1 US Dollar = 120 KSHS**. Credit/Debit cards are normally accepted by most hotels, banks, restaurants, and tourist shops.



Weather and Clothing

The current maximum day-time temperature is approximately 30°C and night-time temperature is about 24°C.



Security

The meeting venue and its surroundings are secure. However, it is important that every participant behave him/herself in a way that is familiar to the environment to ensure the safety and security of all participants.

As organizers, we will try our best to ensure that people are safe and in a secure venue. If you feel unconvinced about anything at all, please inform us.

Be informed that causing drama and violence will disqualify you to be part of this workshop.

Always exercise the usual level of alertness, and take special care of your money, mobile phones, cameras, laptops, etc.



Covid-19 & Yellow Fever Regulations

All participants entering Kenya that are fully vaccinated will not be required to provide a negative PCR test result. Please travel with your Vaccination Certificate. If not vaccinated, you shall be required to provide a negative PCR test result on arrival obtained within 72 hours before departure. You should also be in possession of a Yellow Fever vaccination certificate upon entry. The cost of the Covid PCR test shall be covered by WACI Health upon presenting a receipt.

Please note that it is now a mandatory requirement for all passengers arriving in Kenya to fill in The COVID-19 Travelers Health Surveillance Form. The forms must be filled online via https://ears.health.go.ke/airline_registration/ Passengers will be required to display the received QR codes to port health officials for them to be allowed to proceed to arrival immigration.



Visa Status

All passengers from countries that require an e-visa to enter Kenya must apply prior to the travel date and obtain an e-visa through <https://evisakenya.net/>

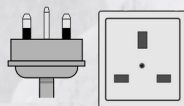
- Participants who require Visa on arrival should carry \$50 which will be paid at the airport.
- WACI Health will refund ordinary visa fees. Make sure you request a receipt at the airport and present it to the WACI Health team stationed at the workshop.



Extra Information

Kenya is in the East Africa Time Zone, UTC+3.

- Kenya currency is the Kenya shilling.
- You will need a passport for foreign exchange transactions.
- The hotel is wireless-enabled, as are the facilities where we accommodate you.
- Kenya has a decent 4G network, but roaming can be prohibitively expensive.
- Kenya plugs are 240 V/50 Hz and are the global G standard (see diagram below)
